• System removable can use on other wells. • Snails will be monitored • Ratio of blending 2 parts lower to I part upper. • Brine disposed off site. • Part of 2005 Water Management Plan. • Upper water used since 1951. • Ground water model shows how much safely pumped. • Cheap source of water for CSD. • With grant will be able to provide water at reasonable rate. S. B. well not being used this will help that well.

We are 50ft to property line.• Waste stored in plastic with lids no nitrate pollution. • Possibly get concession in future to house 5 horses. • Private horses may use state parks looking into moving trail head to Sea Pines property so no Sea Pines horses would use streets.
