- County Updates - see below, email message from Y.Mohabbat, SLO County Public Works

- Concerns

- Corner of Skyline and Solano, near golf course entrance, no signage to slow down, yield to pedestrian traffic -
- Top of Cabrillo Estates, Alamo Drive off Rodman - lots of litter, no signage about litter, using area; misuse of area could be a fire safety issue.
- Ask County about garbage, surplus items left on street - what is process for removal?
- Discussion about change of 1st Street, south of Santa Maria - changes have been made - dirt road has been narrowed, rock edging - unsafe to make turns. What is status?
- Discussion about walkway in Pismo and 3rd Street area onto Sweet Springs - history of wetland area, bring suggestion to attention of Morro Coast Audubon.
- Santa Ysabel fromn 7th to 2nd -- status of traffic speed in area, can speed be lessened?
- South Bay Blvd, can signage be installed before Los Olivos, traveling south to LOVR to slow down traffic/signal ahead

Here they are:

- County Updates

4th and Pismo – Permanent Chicane has been completed and project is in the process of being closed out.

Nipomo at Mtn View, SW corner – This item is still in process and we will be checking the status once received.

Los Olivos at 10th and 9th – No parking has been implemented due to sight distance and visibility concerns.
Went to BOS 7/17 for no parking ordinance

Fairchild at LOVR – No updates and County is still monitoring for any concerns.

Stop Light at Nipomo and South Bay Blvd – Anticipated to go to construction in summer of 2018

Monarch Lane – No changes at this time.

El Moro - 3rd to 12th, Item exhibit to be shown at the next September 2017 meeting demonstrating improvements/enhancements to school zone area and El Moro corridor.
