- 2. COUNTY UPDATES - No County representative present/ no update information provided.
- 5. AGENDA ITEMS, INCLUDING PUBLIC COMMENT

a. LOVR speed, South Bay Blvd to 10th St. presentation by Dave Bowlus on current situation, posted speeds fluctuate within this business district - going east 25mph starts AFTER Fairchild, signage is obstructed by vegetation. Coming west 25mph starts around Chamber office near Palisades. Traffic in area congested at many locations with drivers entering onto LOVR from - Post Office, Ralphs, Grocery Outlet/Rite Aid Center. Dave will send re-cap to County with information he has collected from businesses. Group would like to understand why the entire area is not 25mph.

b. Safer town for multi-modal movement - safe ways to get to Sweet Springs, Baywood area, schools - use of class 1 bikeways or paths. Nothing specific in community plan. Need specific project areas to work on from a comprehensive town plan. Possibly something to work toward for LOCAC. Need to coordinate with other entities - County Bicycle Advisory Council, Trails/Pathways Council - they set priorities within their area of influence.

c. Presentation Celebrate Los Osos - idea of a wayfinder project, to assist visitors in finding the Baywood area, coastal access area - Bear Paws or something on streets to guide motorists/visitors. From LOVR traveling both east and west. May be a safety issue to follow, with all current signage on LOVR. Suggestion of using sailboat for footprint to follow, as Baywood area has coastal access. Main concern from group is safety. Group voted to recommend to LOCAC Board for their input/recommendation.

Celebrate Los Osos wants to apply for grants to assist with project happening, LOCAC support necessary. They will also be updating some signage within Los Osos, working with County Public Works.
