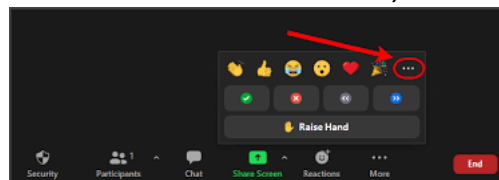

A. DRC2021-00078 Proposed Minor Use Permit to construct an approximately 278 sq ft storage shed on an approximately .48-acre parcel located in Los Osos. This shed had been previously built; they are now applying for permits.

This project was unanimously approved by LUC.
